## THE PONSETI KIDS FOR A CAUSE FUN RUN

The Ponseti Kids For a Cause Fun Run is a fundraiser held by Clubfoot Solutions to raise money for effective clubfoot braces using the Ponseti Method. Nearly 80% of children with congenital clubfoot birth defect are born in developing countries, where their families lack the funds to pay for these braces. The Fun Run is a run, not a race, and is a family-friendly event for children 13 and under and their families. The cost is \$25 for a single runner and \$50 for families. Former MLB pitcher and clubfoot child Jim Mecir will be in attendance as well as many children Clubfoot Solutions has benefited throughout the years.
